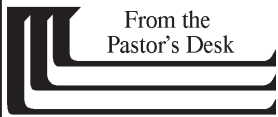

Dear Parishioners,

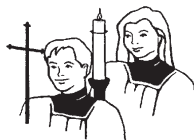
This Friday Fr. Anthony will return to his Capuchin Community in India. We have been fortunate to have Fr. Anthony these summer months and hopefully we will see him again. As you might know, Fr. Anthony spent four years as a missionary in the African Country called Burkina Faso, which is a small landlocked country in the west of Africa. It is amazing to hear him recount his experiences in this developing nation. One heartening aspect is how vibrant our Catholic Faith is in this land which includes a wide range of faiths. Furthermore, it is interesting to note that Fr. Anthony added to his Missionary experience in the United States, here in Walden. Father will celebrate the 11:00 Mass, then on Friday fly back to India. We thank Fr. Anthony for his service to our parish and hopefully we will see him again.

With Fr. Anthony's departure, the 9:00 am Thursday morning Mass will discontinue. This Thursday, Sept. 8 will be the last Thursday morning Mass.

September 8, which is the feast of the Birthday of the Blessed Mother, is also the opening of Most Precious Blood School. 2016 marks the 50th year of the school. We are fortunate to have an excellent new principal: Mr. Woodward Hallaway. He is helping to keep our technology current. In fact the great goal this year is to bring wireless access to the entire building. At present, we have some wireless connection, and each classroom, as well as the computer lab, is connected by "hard wire" so students can do research online and teachers can access the web in using the smart boards. There are new desks for the kindergarten and for eighth grade. We are looking forward to an excellent year.
