

Well, with the arrival of Summer—here are a few book recommendations you might add to your reading list. For non fiction: The Jesuit Guide to Almost Everything by Rev. James Martin S.J. is a fantastic read about the Catholic Spiritual life and in fact is a New York Times Bestseller. For those ready for a deeper read in terms of theology and the link between faith and reason The Religious Sense by Luigi Giussani is very enriching. It can be heavy going, but for those who plow through, it can be very enriching. For an insightful book on the role of Faith in our shifting culture, Bad Religion by Ross Douthat has some amazing insights. Those interested in the origins of the New Testament will probably find The Canon of Scripture by F.F. Bruce to be a very enjoyable and informative read. Looking back a few years, Footprints in a Darkened Forest by Bishop Fulton Sheen is certainly inspiring. Those looking for some fiction with a Catholic spin might enjoy Father Elijah an Apocalypse by Michael D. O'Brien. Reading through the book of Revelations might be helpful before reading this last suggestion.

A more recent book, though a bit thick is: <u>Jesus a Pilgrimage</u> by Fr. James Martin. This book recounts his pilgrimage to the Holy Land. And finally Pope Benedict XVI's <u>Holiness Is Always In Season</u> is an excellent reflection on the likes of the saints.






