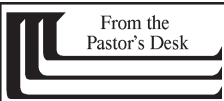

Pastor's Desk

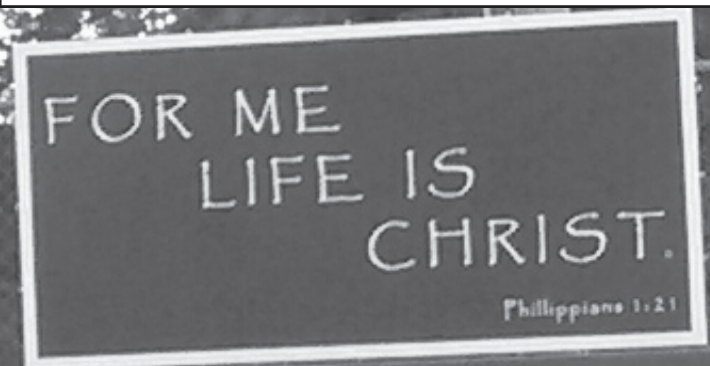
Dear Parishioners,
