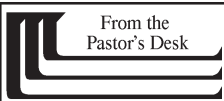

His visit to the Cathedral for Evening Prayer (Vespers) and the celebration of the Mass at Madison Square Garden was the Church coming together to pray with the leadership of the Vicar of Christ. I hope his visit has enlivened the faith of our Catholic Community and all followers of Christ. Part of our challenge is to maintain that balance – being a people of prayer and also a people of service – helping those who live on the margins.

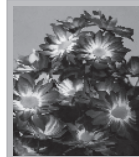
