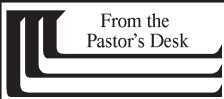

Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Last Saturday the Knights of Columbus sponsored a Pasta Dinner with the proceeds going to the area food banks. What a fantastic meal! And in addition to good food, it is also fun to get together with people from the parish – our parish community – and share a meal. Thanks are extended to the Knights for an enjoyable evening.

Kudos also to our Religious Education Coordinator, Mrs. Lori Mahoney, who will receive recognition for two accomplishments at the Maryknoll Center in Ossining today. Along with several other Coordinators of Religious Ed from the Archdiocese, Mrs. Mahoney completed Level II Catechetical training and also completed the Catechetical Leadership training, and will receive a Catechetical Certificate indicating the same. Well done!

This week a letter was received from His Eminence, Cardinal Dolan, informing us of the updated annulment process. As you might have read in Catholic New York, previously when annulments were concluded in New York, each case would then be sent to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia for review. This process was called the “Court of Second Instance.” Each diocese would have a corresponding diocese to which annulments would be sent for review. Upon consultation with the bishops and canon lawyers, Pope Francis has removed this step. Apparently, this will accelerate the process. Furthermore, starting December 8, there will be no charge to administer the annulment process. There will still be a cost, but resources will be moved from other ministries in the Church in order to carry the cost. So, if you are in need of an annulment, you are certainly encouraged to come by the rectory and begin this process.

This year’s service will occur on Tuesday, November 24 at 7:00 p.m. at Most Precious Blood Church. Please come and pray with your Walden neighbors.

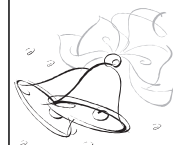


There will be a Mass of Thanksgiving for the Parish at the 9:00 a.m. Mass Thanksgiving morning.
