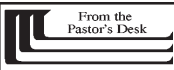

Dear Parishioners,
 Today we begin the Season of Advent, which is also the start of the Church's Liturgical calendar. Advent is the season we prepare for the great celebration of Christmas. Now granted, in the stores we have already seen Christmas trees for a few months, but for us, Advent is a time distinct from Christmas. Furthermore, Advent is a season we experience mostly at Church, although some families will have an Advent Wreath. How to make Advent different? Well this becomes a busy time of year – so it is good to try to maintain a consistent prayer life at home, and maybe even pray the rosary as a family, for instance before dinner. And in these Catholic practices – we experience Advent beyond Church. Another aspect of Advent – is going to confession. We have the usual confession schedule, as listed on the cover, but there is also the special confession day – Monday Dec. 14, from 4:00 to 8:00.

Other signs of Advent – the outdoor Nativity goes up (but without the Christ child). We know from experience that this needs to be done before the snow starts falling. It is also the time when we start to bring in gifts for Operation Dalmatian, the Christmas program which occurs every year in the village.

There is also the Christmas concert on Saturday Dec. 12 at 7:00 in Fr. Sullivan Hall, which is always a fun time. Soda will be provided, but please feel free to bring your own snacks and refreshments.
