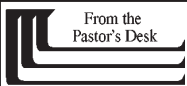

Cardinal Dolan has extended an invitation to all young men who might have some questions about the Priesthood in the Archdiocese of New York, the details are listed below. Priests and nuns are essential for the life of the Church and for those who are called – that is the path of happiness and holiness. Ultimately, priests and nuns come from strong families who love Christ and His Church. This is a great opportunity to learn more about the path to the priesthood.

Moving to questions of building and maintenance: the ceiling over the altar isn't looking too good, the tiles are slowly coming undone some of the rings at the bottom of the lights no longer function. Sometime after Easter, repairs on the ceiling will begin.

There are not many Fridays left for Stations of the Cross – so if you have not been to Stations yet, you are certainly encouraged to come. Now of course there is no explicit obligation, as there is to attend Sunday Mass or a Holy Days of Obligation, but hopefully our faith is not just reduced to what is mandated. Coming together to pray the Stations is a long tradition in our faith, and hopefully helps us reflect on the suffering Christ endured to save us from our sins.

Finally, the Cardinal's Appeal is going well, here is where we stand: 57 gifts for a total of \$16,520, which is about 42% of our goal – so a few more gifts should get us over the goal line.
