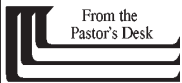

Dear Parishioners,

Pentecost Sunday is one of the most ancient feasts on the Church calendar. Celebrated early enough to be mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (20:16) and St. Paul's First letter to the Corinthians (16:18). It is the 50th day after Easter, and it supplants the Jewish feast of Pentecost, which took place 50 days after the Passover and celebrated the sealing of the Old Covenant on Mt. Sinai. Furthermore it is the start of the public mission of the Church when the disciples continued the work of Christ, proclaiming the Kingdom of God and bringing thousands then millions to Christ through His Church. Pentecost is also the genesis of the sacrament of Confirmation.

In addition to Pentecost, May is a busy time here at MPB. Last Saturday we celebrated our last two First Holy Communion Masses, and it was certainly a happy time in the parish. Last Thursday we began our **Scripture Study: The Acts of the Apostles** – which is an amazing book in the New Testament; we had a good turnout, think about coming next Thursday. Next Saturday we will come together from 2:00 to 3:00 for a holy hour, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament and praying the Rosary in this month of Mary. The following Sunday we will have our Corpus Christi procession, though this year it will follow the 9:00 Mass. Traditionally we processed after the 11:00 but with the 12:30 Mass now at Wallkill, that is not possible.

Speaking of Wallkill, the 100th Anniversary Committee is certainly busy. Here is a rough schedule of upcoming events. First – a chicken dinner fundraiser at Pop's Pavilion on Saturday July 16 – which is appropriate in that the feast of St. Benedict is July 11. Also – we are planning, with the help of a future Eagle Scout, of putting up a small garden to house a statue of St. Benedict. Then later in the year – next summer – will be the 100th anniversary Mass which will be followed by coffee and donuts and desserts after Mass under a large tent. And finally, a barbeque celebration in Oct. 2017. Watch the bulletin and parish website for more details.

On a personal note – I joined five of my classmates last Wednesday for evening prayer and dinner in Yonkers, celebrating our 20th anniversary to the Priesthood, which was a great time. Hopefully some young men will come from our Parish to be ordained, something which appears to never have happened. Finally, I received an email from Fr. Antony, he will be flying in from India on June 7, and will remain with us during the Summer.
