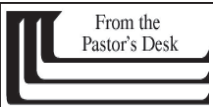

From the
Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, which is the Latin phrase for “Body of Christ”. Before 1962, when people received Holy Communion, that is what the priest would say and of course the response was “Amen”. This is a day when we celebrate the sacrament of the Eucharist, the source and summit of Christ life. The feast day, which dates back to 1264, was traditionally celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. Thursday was acknowledged as a special day in that Christ instituted the Eucharist on Holy Thursday, so it was fitting that Corpus Christi was celebrated on a Thursday. For many centuries, this was the tradition, but the Church in the United States opted to move this beautiful feast day to the Sunday after Trinity Sunday so that it would be celebrated by the largest portion of the Church which comes to Mass on Sundays. The orations for this Mass, that is the opening prayer, the prayer over the gifts before the Holy, Holy and the closing prayer, were each written by the Dominican Priests and doctor of the Church St. Thomas Aquinas. This feast day is a bit unique in that traditionally the parish comes together for the celebration of the Mass—but also many parishes have a procession. A procession of the Blessed Sacrament is a quiet form of evangelization—bringing Christ to the streets.

Thanks are extended to everyone who contributed to the BABY SHOWER for Good Council Homes. Pauline Barry and Raul Morales brought all the donations down to the Good Council home in Spring Valley, last Thursday. Kudos to our Culture of Life Committee for the work on this important ministry.
