From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parishioners,

Every now and then I come upon a couple in the parish who are married, but not married in the Church. Now, as you might recall, when people who are Catholic get married, the marriage needs to be in the Church, that is, the grace of Christ needs to be part of that relationship. The grace of marriage comes to the man and woman through the sacrament of marriage. Now granted, sometimes a person has previously been married in the Church, and sadly enough sometimes things simply don't work out, and the couple gets a divorce. That is a reality in our society today and the Church tries to help with the possibility of an annulment. Other times however, there is no previous marriage and a couple just has never gotten around to getting married in the Church. Well if this is the case with anyone reading this bulletin, I encourage you to repeat your vows in the presence of a priest and get married within the Church, and in turn to receive the grace of Christ through the sacrament. This option is called: convalidation. For instance, if a couple were married by a justice of the peace, and neither has been previously married, well to get married in the Church is pretty simple. Please call the rectory and set up an appointment.

On another topic, I was really pleasantly surprised last weekend when I saw the Catholic New York: it had pictures of the hundredth anniversary of the Chapel on the front cover and the back cover!
